

## **TOWN OF UNIONVILLE MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Town Council of the Town of Unionville held a public hearing at 7:15 p.m. on Monday, December 18, 2017. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear comments regarding the naming of three roads within Town of Unionville limits created by Monroe Expressway. Those roads are:

- A. Portion of SR 9, located between Willis Long Road and the Monroe Expressway. Recommended name: Blue Jay Road
- B. Portion of Poplin Road, located between Secret Short Cut Road and the Monroe Expressway. Recommended name: Heath Davis Road
- C. Portion of Y 206 and Poplin Road, located between Roanoke Church Road and the Monroe Expressway. Recommended name: Poplin Road

Mayor Baucom and all Commissioners were present for the public hearing. Attorney Ken Helms was absent.

Mayor Baucom called the public hearing to order. No one signed up to speak at the public hearing.

Clerk Gaddy stated that Union County and other municipalities are considering road names for several roads created by the Monroe Expressway, three of which have portions in Unionville's town limits. Unionville has been asked to make a recommendation for these three new roads to Union County. A county-wide public hearing was held in December after a suggestion period, and the three names above were recommended.

There being no other comments, Mayor Baucom declared the public hearing adjourned.
