

**TOWN OF UNIONVILLE
MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Town of Unionville Town Council held a public hearing at 7:15 p.m. on Monday, February 20, 2017 in Town Hall, 1102 Unionville Church Road, Monroe, NC. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear public comments regarding Annexation #24, five parcels on Deese Road. Mayor Simpson and all Commissioners were present. Town Attorney Ken Helms was also present.

Mayor Simpson welcomed everyone and called the public hearing to order.

Mayor Simpson recognized Clerk Sonya Gaddy, who introduced the annexation, stating that it consists of five parcels along Deese Road which border the existing Town limit. She distributed maps showing the existing Town limits and the location of these five parcels. All of the criteria have been met for annexation, including posting the property and advertising the public hearing in the local newspaper on February 10 and 12, 2017.

There being no other comments, Mayor Simpson declared the public hearing adjourned.
