

**TOWN OF UNIONVILLE
MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Town Council of the Town of Unionville held a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, July 17, 2017 in Unionville Town Hall, 1102 Unionville Church Road, Monroe, NC. The purpose of the hearing was to hear comments from the public regarding Annexation #25, ten parcels along Emerald Pointe Court and a portion of an adjoining lot on Baucom Deese Road. Mayor Simpson and Commissioners Randy Baucom, Andrew Benton, Ken Brown and Edd Little were present. Commissioner Jaren Simpson and Attorney Ken Helms were absent.

Mayor Simpson called the public hearing to order and recognized Clerk Sonya Gaddy, who reported that Mr. Benton and Mr. Smith have petitioned for voluntary annexation and provided all of the information required to this point. The required public hearing was advertised in the local paper on Friday, July 7 and Sunday, July 9, 2017. Approval of this voluntary annexation will be considered during the regular meeting at 7:30 p.m. tonight.

Mr. Brian Benton addressed Council and stated that he wishes to annex these ten properties into the Town of Unionville, and urged Council to make a favorable decision.

There being no one else wishing to speak, Mayor Simpson declared the public hearing adjourned.
