

**TOWN OF UNIONVILLE  
MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Town Council of the Town of Unionville held a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, June 19, 2017 in Town Hall, 1102 Unionville Church Road, Monroe, NC. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear comments regarding the 2017-2018 Town Budget. Mayor Simpson and all Commissioners were present. Town Attorney Ken Helms was absent.

Mayor Simpson called the public hearing to order and welcomed everyone.

Mayor Simpson recognized Town Budget and Finance Officer Darrell Baucom, who reviewed the proposed budget. Mr. Baucom stated that this budget assumes a \$.02 tax rate. It allows the Town to put \$145,000 to the fund balance, for a total of \$269,910. Franchise taxes are reduced from last year. Alcohol and beverages taxes are not included, as they were received in late May—approximately \$28,000. This figure must be divided throughout the county, not just from the one store in Unionville. Town of Fairview received \$17,000-\$18,000. Contributions are \$85,000, as last year the Town gave an extra donation to Unionville Volunteer Fire Department for the training tower, and also gave a donation to Unionville Community Center for the roof.

There being no one else to speak regarding the 2017-2018 budget, Mayor Simpson declared the public hearing adjourned.
