

TOWN OF UNIONVILLE MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Town Council of the Town of Unionville held a public hearing on Monday, October 17, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. in Town Hall, 1102 Unionville Church Road, Monroe, NC. The purpose of the public hearing was to hear comments regarding Annexation #23 – Silverthorne subdivision, located off Deese Road.
